What data do we collect?

Our Company collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (name, email address, phone number, postcode, IP address), which is individually identifiable information, namely information that identifies an individual or may with reasonable effort identify an individual.
- Non-personal Information, like aggregated usage information and technical information transmitted by your device, including certain software and hardware information (e.g. the type of browser and operating system your device uses, language preference, access time, etc.) in order to enhance the functionality of our Site. We may also collect information on your activity on the Site (e.g. pages viewed, online browsing, clicks, actions, etc.).

How do we collect your data?

You directly provide Our Company with most of the data we collect. We collect data and process data when you:

- Register online or place an order for any of our products or services or fill out an online form to get a quote or personalised help from our staff.
- Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

Our Company may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources:

- From third-party providers, services and public registers (for example, traffic analytics vendors).

How will we use your data?

Our Company collects your data so that we can:

- Process your order and manage your account.
- Email you with special offers on other products and services we think you might like.
- Communicating with you – sending you notices regarding our services, providing you with technical information and responding to any enquiry or customer service issue you may have.

If you agree, Our Company may transfer or disclose Personal Information to our subsidiaries, affiliated companies and subcontractors.

When Our Company processes your order, it may send your data to, and also use the resulting information from, credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent purchases.

How do we store your data?

Our Company securely stores your data digitally on 1&1 ionos's servers.

Our Company will keep your data as long as you use our website or services, or for 5 years thereafter. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data automatically.

Marketing

Our Company would like to send you information about products and services of ours that we think you might like.

If you have agreed to receive marketing, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop Our Company from contacting you for marketing purposes.

If you no longer wish to be contacted for marketing purposes, please write an email to us.

What are your data protection rights?

Our Company would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Our Company for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Our Company correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Our Company to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Our Company erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Our Company restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Our Company’s processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Our Company transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our websites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

- **Google Analytics** – Google Analytics is Google’s analytics tool that helps website and app owners to understand how their visitors engage with their properties. It may use a set of cookies to collect information and report site usage statistics without personally identifying individual visitors to our website.
